Prizes:	The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a hand stitched English Leather headcollar to the para-equestrian driver and young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) with the lowest overall score (irrespective of the class entered). If the driver with the lowest overall score is already in receipt of a Saddlers' prize in 2018, the headcollar for that event will be awarded to the next eligible driver. Multiple prizes will not be awarded.
Raehills Challenge:	On Saturday evening (on foot!), for teams of four people (at least one of which must be a driver or a steward). £10 to enter. Teams may enter a maximum of two times. £100 prize for fastest team.
Interclub Challenge:	Affiliated Clubs may enter a team to include 1 Single Pony, 1 Single Horse and 1 Multiple (pair, tandem or four). Points will be allocated upon final placing of each team member within their respective class. Team members must be nominated by 0900 Saturday 29th July .
Stabling:	Horseboxes, caravans and portable stabling will be welcome in the area allocated as the stable field from Friday 27 July afternoon. Earlier access may be available on request. There would be no guarantee of all services being available prior to the 28th. Matting is compulsory under bedding in portable stabling at all National events. A payment to cover the cost of restitution of the ground may be levied for non-compliance.
Dogs:	Dogs are welcome if kept on leads at all times.
Catering, bar and entertainment:	Catering van on site from Friday evening. Saturday Night Party: There will be BBQs available to cook on and some nibbles available to allow for a social get together. Please bring your own food to BBQ and own drink.
Marathon information:	Marathon consists of mainly forestry tracks and fields. The course has been significantly upgraded since the event's inception. Further works have been carried out this year again to improve the course and take account of competitors' feedback.
