Prizes:	Sandringham Medals to winners. Rosettes 1st to 6th in each class with commemorative rosettes to all competitors and grooms. The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a hand stitched English Leather headcollar to the para-equestrian driver and young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) with the lowest overall score (irrespective of the class entered). If the driver with the lowest overall score is already in receipt of a Saddlers' prize in 2018, the headcollar for that event will be awarded to the next eligible driver. Multiple prizes will not be awarded.	
Stabling:	Competitors are asked to report to the Stable Managers on arrival and to park where directed please. Electric fencing will be allowed but only in a designated area. The size of an uncovered pen is limited to 10ft x 10ft only one pen per competitor, unless otherwise pre-arranged with the OC. The enclosure must be securely attached to a vehicle or trailer to prevent it being moved or dislodged by the horse or pony within. Competitors must advise the Stable Managers on arrival so that they can be parked accordingly. No horses/ponies may be tethered. Paper bedding will NOT be permitted. Only horses/ponies entered for this event will be allowed on the Sandringham Showground. Matting is compulsory under bedding in portable stabling at all National Events. A payment to cover the cost of restitution of the ground may be levied for non-compliance. No entry to Stabling Area before 09.00 Wed 27 June 2018.

Caravans and additional vehicles:	Maximum of ONE caravan per competitor will be permitted to park in the stabling area; any additional caravans may be required to park in an adjacent area and will be charged £10.00 per night or £25 for the duration paid in advance with entry. Caravan passes will be sent by return. These must be displayed on entry.	
ATVs/Scooters:	It is highly recommended that hard hats are worn whilst riding quad bikes/motorbikes on the showground. They MUST be worn on the public road. The vehicle MUST only be ridden by the number of people for which it is designed and NOT ridden by children. Failure to comply - Yellow Card.
