Withdrawals:	By 2000 Wednesday 25 July to the Entries Secretary
Prizes:	The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a hand stitched English Leather headcollar to the para-equestrian driver and young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) with the lowest overall score (irrespective of the class entered). If the driver with the lowest overall score is already in receipt of a Saddlers' prize in 2018, the headcollar for that event will be awarded to the next eligible driver. Multiple prizes will not be awarded.
Stabling:	Corral stabling permitted using electric fencing and portable stabling accepted using matting, subject to approval by the Stable Manager.
Additional vehicles:	Permitted without charge.
ATVs/Scooters:	Hard hats must be worn at all times. Failure to do so will incur penalty points being awarded to the competitor involved.
Dogs:	Dogs MUST be kept in the lorry park and on a lead at all times.
Catering:	Wine and Cheese Reception, Friday evening 27 July. Hot meal and live music on Saturday evening, B.Y.O.B. Mobile catering available on site all weekend.
Marathon information:	Using estate roads, tracks and lanes in the park and some forest trails. May be on small country roads. Flat terrain, grassy paddocks. Seven obstacles with possibility of a water obstacle.
Health & Safety:	Health & Safety standards will be enforced always. All persons on the showground or course will be held responsible for complying with these standards at all times and must not put themselves or any other person at risk in any way whatsoever. Any accident or incident must be reported to the Safety Officer or the Event Secretary immediately. A report will be entered in the Accident Book and the relevant forms completed.
Location:	<p>Postcode: BT66 7QA. From Belfast, take M1 West and exit at Junction 9, Moira. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto A3 into Moira town. Continue through the town and proceed through Magheralin and Dollingstown villages, remaining on the A3 following signs for Lurgan. After the EMO petrol station on your left, continue for 200m to traffic lights. Take left onto A26, direction Craigavon, Banbridge and Gilford. Follow signs for Banbridge. At the small roundabout, take 1st exit for Banbridge A26. Continue for 1.5 miles into Waringstown village. After the S bend in the middle of the village, take the first right onto Clare Road. The event field is approx. 400m on the right and will be signposted.</p> <p>From Dublin, take N1 to the Banbridge exit. Go past the first exit for Banbridge and Outlet Park and the 2nd exit Banbridge, Rathfriland and The Bronte Homeland and proceed to the 3rd exit on the left for Banbridge and Craigavon A26. Go through the mini roundabout and continue past the BP petrol station into Banbridge town. At the traffic lights, get into the right hand lane for Craigavon, Gilford and airport A26. Continue for approx. 2 miles to roundabout, taking 2nd exit for Lurgan and International airport A26. Proceed for approx. 3 miles into Waringstown village. Turn left going down the hill after the 30mph sign, direction "Clare" and event field is approx. 400 m on the right hand side and will be signposted.</p>
