<b>Withdrawals:</b>	Friday 25 May 2018 Tel. 01428 288301
<b>Prizes:</b>	Rosettes down to 6th place for each class. The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a hand stitched English Leather headcollar to the para-equestrian driver and young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) with the lowest overall score (irrespective of the class entered). If the driver with the lowest overall score is already in receipt of a Saddlers' prize in 2018, the headcollar for that event will be awarded to the next eligible driver. Multiple prizes will not be awarded.
<b>Stabling:</b>	Horseboxes and portable stabling are welcome in the horse box park although caravans may need to be parked in a separate area close by as space is limited. Competitors should not arrive before 12 noon on Friday 1 June. Grass protection mats should be used in portable stabling and horse enclosures. Electric fencing is allowed but please report your requirement to the Stable manager and only use this during night time.
<b>Caravans and additional vehicles:</b>	Entrants will receive two vehicle passes. If you require additional ones they can be purchased from the entries secretary at a cost of £10.00
<b>ATVs/Scooters:</b>	These are allowed but are restricted to the competition area. If driven on the road they need to be road legal. This is a Crown Estate Rule.
<b>Dogs:</b>	Must be kept on leads and under control.
<b>Catering:</b>	On site catering on Saturday and Sunday. We are organising a meal and some entertainment for Saturday evening. Further information will be given to entrants with their acknowledgement of entry. 2 tickets for the Saturday Night meal are included within the price of the entry. Further tickets can be obtained by the Entries Secretary
<b>Veterinary:</b>	A vet and a farrier will be available on Sunday. Otherwise they will be on call at other times.
<b>Marathon information:</b>	Windsor Park has a combination of tarmac roads, stone and grass tracks with small undulating hills and a combination of open meadow and woodland. There is a Deer Park and areas for Game Birds. All seven obstacles are made from post and rail with some within trees and others in the open. One may have a water feature.
<b>Health &amp; Safety:</b>	Health and Safety standards will be enforced always. All persons on the showground or course will be held responsible for complying with these standards at all times and will not put themselves or any other person at risk in any way whatsoever.
<b>Location:</b>	Windsor Driving Trials is held within Windsor Great Park, Windsor, Berkshire. Entry is gained via <b>Blacknest Gate</b> (postcode SL6 0PT) which can be found off the A30 or A308.
