<b>Marathon information:</b>	14-16 km on parkland and tracks. 7 obstacles sited in the parkland around the beautiful lakes. An outstanding water obstacle crossing to an island.
<b>Health &amp; Safety:</b>	Risk assessment posted on Notice Board. Health & Safety standards will be enforced. All persons on the showground or course will be held responsible for complying with these standards at all times and must not put themselves or any other person at risk in any way whatsoever. Any accident or incident must be reported to the Safety Officer or the Event Secretary immediately. A report will be entered in the Accident Book and the relevant forms completed.
<b>Location:</b>	Allerton Park is located immediately to the east of the A1M at Junction 47. After leaving the A1M take the A59 towards York. In 200 metres turn left & then right at the T junction at the bottom of the slip road onto the A168 towards Boroughbridge. Showground is on the right in just under 1 mile. Post code HG5 0SE. Post code is NOT accurate for box park entrance. <b>DO NOT FOLLOW SIGNS FOR ALLERTON CASTLE.</b>

(Selection Forms can be downloaded from the web site or obtained from your Class Representative).*

*If the driver is under 18 years of age, the name of a responsible adult (over 18) who will be able to attend in case the driver's horse(s) are selected for drug testing, must be given on the entry form.*
