<b>Prizes:</b>	The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a training voucher to each para driver and young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) who completes 3 National or Regional events in one calendar year (the National Championships may count as one of the events). Multiple prizes will not be awarded.
<b>Stabling:</b>	Competitors are requested to report to the Stable Manager on arrival at Ashfields and park where directed. No electric fencing to be used for stabling unless by special permission. Only horses/ponies entered for the event will be allowed on the showground. Matting is compulsory under bedding in portable stabling at all national events. A payment to cover the cost of restoration of the ground may be levied for non-compliance.
<b>Dogs:</b>	Must be on leads.
<b>Catering:</b>	Friday evening entertainment: Pimm's reception for volunteers, sponsors, judges and competitors with all welcome in the club house.  Saturday evening entertainment, Meal and disco. The meal will be a hog roast buffet and desert. Cost £12 per head. This can be prepaid with your entry online or at the show, which must be paid before 6pm on Thursday 2 May. Please text Zoe with your bookings prior to the show as the organisers need to know numbers!  Ashfields club house will be open from Thursday morning serving hot snacks during the day, evening meals and the licensed bar will be open.
<b>Veterinary &amp; Farrier:</b>	Blair Court Equine Clinic on call throughout the event. Farrier on call during the event. Call-out fees to be paid by the Competitor.
<b>Marathon information:</b>	The marathon runs over fields and farm tracks with a small section on roads. The obstacles are all within walking distance of each other and not far from the stable field. 7 or 8 obstacles with 1 water obstacle.
<b>Health &amp; Safety</b>	Health and Safety standards will be enforced always. All persons on the showground or course will be held responsible for complying with these standards at all times and will not put themselves or any other person at risk in any way whatsoever. Any accidents shall be reported to the Safety Officer or the Events Secretary at the time of the occurrence. A report shall be entered into the Accident Report book and the relevant forms completed.

(Selection Forms can be downloaded from the web site or obtained from your Class Representative).*

*If the driver is under 18 years of age, the name of a responsible adult (over 18) who will be able to attend in case the driver's horse(s) are selected for drug testing, must be given on the entry form.*
