<b>Marathon:</b>	3 Sections with 8 obstacles (6 for Novice classes and 7 for Intermediates).
<b>Obstacle Cone Driving:</b>	As normal, the Lowther Derby calculated separately for prize money.
<b>Qualifiers:</b>	British Carriagedriving National Championships
<b>Selection:</b>	FEI World Single Horse Championships 2020. The cones for this class will be an international World Championships course. Advanced Horse competitors may join in the Lowther Derby as an extra competition.

<b>Withdrawals:</b>	Monday 5 August. No Refund of entries but free entry in 2020
<b>Prizes:</b>	Prize money will be divided between the classes for The Lowther Derby competition. The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a training voucher to each para driver and young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) who completes 3 National or Regional events in one calendar year (the National Championships may count as one of the events). Multiple prizes will not be awarded.
<b>Stabling:</b>	The stabling area will be situated close to the show ground. <b>Matting compulsory to protect the ground.</b> You must inform us if you intend to use electric fences and report to the stable manager who will show you to your allocated position on a fence line. BC rules must be observed. Annex 14, point 8.
<b>Caravans:</b>	No extra charge, everyone is welcome. You may be asked to help with a delegated job.
<b>ATVs/Scooters:</b>	The wearing of a helmet whilst riding on ATV is not a legal requirement, however we do strongly recommend that you wear head protection. Insurance of all motor vehicles is the responsibility of the vehicle owner/driver or Rider, not Lowther Estates.
<b>Dogs:</b>	Dogs allowed, but must be kept on a lead at all times. If your dog cannot be relied upon when left tethered and unattended, then please do not leave it unattended.
<b>Catering:</b>	Catering will be available on the show ground. Welcome reception on Friday evening at 7pm in the HDT Marquee. There will be a barbecue / carvery event on Saturday evening. Bring your own drinks. Tickets from Chris Atkins.
<b>Veterinary:</b>	Frame & Swift, Carleton, Penrith    Tel. 01768 862454
<b>Marathon information:</b>	Section A will take place on estate land around Lowther Castle. Competitors can expect stunning Lakeland countryside with vast landscapes. Section B takes place within Lowther Home Park and adjacent to the Country Fair. Eight obstacles.
<b>Cones course:</b>	The cones course will be judged as normal with 3 points for ball down and one point per second over the time allowed. The course will include cones, a bridge and 2 obstacles. For those wishing to cut the mustard, a second evaluation will be made for the The Lowther Derby- prize money to be awarded and will not affect your final score.
<b>Health &amp; Safety:</b>	Health and Safety standards will be enforced always. All persons on the showground or course will be held responsible for complying with these standards at all times and will not put themselves or any other person at risk in any way whatsoever.
<b>Location:</b>	M6 from the South, take exit 39 Shap. Head North on A6 for 4 Miles. Turn left for Lowther. M6 from the North, exit 40. Follow A6 South. 4miles from Penrith, turn right for Lowther. Postcode CA10 2HH.
