Prizes:	The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a training voucher to each para driver and young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) who completes 3 National or Regional events in one calendar year (the National Championships may count as one of the events). Multiple prizes will not be awarded.
Interclub Challenge:	Affiliated Clubs may enter a team to include 1 Single Pony, 1 Single Horse and 1 Multiple (pair, tandem or four). Points will be allocated upon final placing of each team member within their respective class. Team members must be nominated by 0900 Saturday 27 July.
Stabling:	Horseboxes, caravans and portable stabling will be welcome in the area allocated as the stable field from Friday 26 July afternoon. Earlier access may be available on request. There would be no guarantee of all services being available prior to the 27 July. Matting is compulsory under bedding in portable stabling at all National events. A payment to cover the cost of restitution of the ground may be levied for non-compliance.
Dogs:	Dogs are welcome if kept on leads at all times.
Catering, bar and entertainment:	Catering van on site from Friday evening. Saturday Night Party: There will be BBQs available to cook on and some nibbles available to allow for a social get together. Please bring your own food to BBQ and own drink.
Veterinary / Farrier	On call. Please contact Stable Manager for details.
Marathon information:	Marathon consists of mainly forestry tracks and fields. The course has been significantly upgraded since the event's inception.

INTERNATIONAL SELECTION CLASSES

A completed International Team Selection Form must be forwarded to the British Carriagedriving Office prior to the event or, at the very latest, be handed to a British Carriagedriving Council Member prior to you starting at your first selection event, i.e. this must be before you begin your Dressage Test! (Selection Forms can be downloaded from the web site or obtained from your Class Representative).

PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

If the driver is under 18 years of age, the name of a responsible adult (over 18) who will be able to attend in case the driver's horse(s) are selected for drug testing, must be given on the entry form.
