Prizes:	Sandringham Medals to winners. Rosettes 1st to 6th in each class. Dressage, Marathon and Cones rosettes 1 st to 3 rd . Commemorative rosettes to all competitors and grooms. The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a training voucher to each para driver and young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) who completes 3 National or Regional events in one calendar year (the National Championships may count as one of the events). Multiple prizes will not be awarded.
Stabling:	Competitors are asked to report to the Stable Managers on arrival and to park where directed please. Electric fencing will be allowed but please advise the Stable Managers on arrival so those who have electric fencing can be parked accordingly. Pen size: 12ftx12ft, unless pre-arranged with the OC. No horses/ponies may be tethered. Paper bedding will NOT be permitted. Matting is compulsory under bedding in portable stabling. Only horses/ponies entered for this event will be allowed on the Sandringham Showground. No entry to Stabling Area before 09.30 Wed 26 June 2019.
Stabling for hire and Electric Hook-up:	There may be availability in the Laycocks field (where the Coaching and AIAT are parked) If you are interested please contact the Entries Secretary Rachel Masters drivenmadx2@aol.co.uk
Caravans and additional vehicles:	Only ONE Caravan per competitor to park in the stabling area due to space, so any additional caravans may be required to park in an adjacent area, with a charge of £10.00 per night or £25.00 for the duration paid in advance with entry. All Caravan passes will be sent in the post by return. PLEASE display these on entry to Stable Manager.
ATVs/Scooters:	It is highly recommended that hard hats are worn whilst riding quad bikes/motorbikes on the showground. They MUST be worn on the public roads. The vehicle MUST only be ridden by the number of people for which it is designed and NOT ridden by children. Failure to comply - Yellow Card.

INTERNATIONAL SELECTION CLASSES

A completed International Team Selection Form must be forwarded to the British Carriagedriving Office prior to the event or, at the very latest, be handed to a British Carriagedriving Council Member prior to you starting at your first selection event, i.e. this must be before you begin your Dressage Test! (Selection Forms can be downloaded from the web site or obtained from your Class Representative).

PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

If the driver is under 18 years of age, the name of a responsible adult (over 18) who will be able to attend in case the driver's horse(s) are selected for drug testing, must be given on the entry form.
