<b>Driven Dressage:</b>	BC Dressage Tests for 2019 will apply. 2 arenas, 100x40 and 80x40. Pairs classes must specify their required dressage test at the time of entry. Para drivers - IPEC Test No.4
<b>Marathon:</b>	3 Sections. Section A approx. 7 km, Section B approx. 8 km. 7 obstacles (6 for Novice classes), possibility of a water obstacle.
<b>Obstacle Cone Driving:</b>	Obstacle Fault Competition. Length to be confirmed after site inspection.
<b>Qualifiers:</b>	British Carriagedriving National Championships
<b>Prizes:</b>	Rosettes and Sashes for all class winners.

<b>Withdrawals:</b>	Tuesday 13 August 2019 by 8pm to the Entries Secretary, 07927 187345
<b>Prizes:</b>	The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a training voucher to each para driver and young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) who completes 3 National or Regional events in one calendar year (the National Championships may count as one of the events). <b>Dogs:</b>	Dogs MUST be kept in the lorry park and on a lead at all times.

<b>Marathon Information:</b>	Using estate roads, grass tracks and gravel lanes in the park, some forest trails. May be on small country roads. Flat terrain, grassy paddocks. Seven obstacles with possibility of a water obstacle.
<b>Location:</b>	Postcode: BT60 4QT. From Belfast docks, follow signs for A12 Westlink, take M1 West bound. Stay on M1 for approx. 38 miles until motorway ends and becomes A4. After approx. 2 miles, turn left onto B45, direction Caledon. After 200 yds at roundabout, take the 2nd exit. After 4 miles, turn right to stay on B45. After approx. 6 miles, keep straight onto Main Street A28 for approx. 0.5 miles before turning right onto B210 Coolkill Road from where event will be signposted.

(Selection Forms can be downloaded from the web site or obtained from your Class Representative).*

*If the driver is under 18 years of age, the name of a responsible adult (over 18) who will be able to attend in case the driver's horse(s) are selected for drug testing, must be given on the entry form.*
