| Prizes: | Rosettes down to 6th place for each class. The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a training voucher to each para driver and young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) who completes 3 National or Regional events in one calendar year (the National Championships may count as one of the events). Multiple prizes will not be awarded. |
| Stabling: | Horseboxes and portable stabling are welcome in the horse box park although caravans may need to be parked in a separate area close by as space is limited. Competitors should not arrive before 12 noon on Friday 31 May. Grass protection mats should be used in portable stabling and horse enclosures. Electric fencing is allowed but please report your requirement to the Stable manager and only use this during night time. |
| Caravans and additional vehicles: | Entrants will receive two vehicle passes. If you require additional ones they can be purchased from the entries secretary at a cost of £10.00 |
| ATVs/Scooters: | These are allowed but have restricted use. Please speak to the Secretary before the event if you are planning on using one. If driven on the road they need to be road legal. This is a Crown Estate Rule. |
| Dogs: | Must be kept on leads and under control. |
| Catering: | On site catering on Saturday and Sunday. We are organising a meal and some entertainment for Saturday evening. Further information will be given to entrants with their acknowledgement of entry. 2 tickets for the Saturday Night meal are included within the price of the entry. Further tickets can be obtained by the Entries Secretary |
| Veterinary: | A vet and a farrier will be available on Sunday. Otherwise they will be on call at other times. |
| Marathon information: | Windsor Park has a combination of tarmac roads, stone and grass tracks with small undulating hills and a combination of open meadow and woodland. There is a Deer Park and areas for Game Birds. All seven obstacles are made from post and rail with some within trees and others in the open. One may have a water feature. |
| Health & Safety: | Health and Safety standards will be enforced always. All persons on the showground or course will be held responsible for complying with these standards at all times and will not put themselves or any other person at risk in any way whatsoever. |
| Location: | Location details will be sent with entry confirmation. The postcode is not yet known as the access gate to the park is still to be confirmed. |

INTERNATIONAL SELECTION CLASSES

A completed International Team Selection Form must be forwarded to the British Carriagedriving Office prior to the event or, at the very latest, be handed to a British Carriagedriving Council Member prior to you starting at your first selection event, i.e. this must be before you begin your Dressage Test! (Selection Forms can be downloaded from the web site or obtained from your Class Representative).

PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

If the driver is under 18 years of age, the name of a responsible adult (over 18) who will be able to attend in case the driver's horse(s) are selected for drug testing, must be given on the entry form.
