We have extensive stabling and grazing pastures, turnout yards, a large grass menage, indoor school, well-schooled ponies and modern equipment.

You will have good coaching skills, sound carriage driving and riding skills and enthusiasm to introduce people of all ages, including those with a disability/additional needs, to the fun and excitement of carriage driving and riding.

UKCC level 1 or BHS/BDS stage 2 equivalent is preferred, assistance to attain a relevant qualification can be provided.

All members of the coaching team Chariots of Fire are involved in the activities required to run and develop a busy yard. Alongside pony and stable care, this includes organising indoor driving trials, hosting outdoor driving events and running local events for carriage drivers and riders. The role includes grooming for disabled drivers at indoor events and club level outdoor events.

The coaches are also encouraged and supported to compete themselves and the yard provides excellent training facilities for event preparation.

The Centre is rural but not isolated, with speedy access both north and south, only 7 miles from a motorway and a mainline station. Private accommodation on site (with Wi-Fi connection) and stabling for one horse is available.
