Competition classes:

Class A: (Pony) 8-14 years, dressage BC Novice A **or** FEI Children (2023), 5 obstacles A-D, marathon section B only.

Class B: (Pony) 15-18 years, dressage BC Novice B **or** FEI Junior (2019)

Class C: (Horse). 14-25 years, dressage BC Open A **or** FEI 3*A HP1

Class C: (Pony). 19-25 years, dressage BC Open A **or** FEI 3*A HP1

Class D: Multiples, 14-25 years, dressage 14-18 years FEI Junior (2019), dressage 18-25 years FEI Under 25

Class E: (Pony) 6-16 years, dressage BC Gateway shapes, 10 cones, 4 obstacles

Dual Entry for drivers also entering the 2 day National event

The organiser may split or amalgamate classes at their discretion.

Driven Dressage: Dressage Arena 80m x 40m

Marathon: 3 sections of approx. 12km in total. 6 obstacles which may include water and a bridge.

Obstacle Cone Driving: Obstacle Fault Competition. The cones course will be same as driven for the national/club competitors, approx. 20 gates. The driving speed will be 220m/min for classes A and E, other classes, 260m/min for single ponies, 250m/min for pony pairs and single horses and 240m/min for pony fours. All singles cones width 160cm.

Start Fee: A start fee of £15 applies to all BYD classes, payable on line and included with your entry. If you are also entering a National class you will only need to pay the National start fee of £30 to BC.

Dual Entries: Some young drivers may wish to also enter a 2 day National class. If this is the case, please fill in both the National and BYD Championships entry forms via the Members Login on the BC website. The BYD entry fee is reduced to £15 if the National has also been entered. This allows the athlete to drive both National and BYD dressage tests and qualify for the BYD Championship.

Please indicate on your National entry that you are also entering the BYD Championship.
