Prizes:	The Worshipful Company of Saddlers will present a training voucher to each para driver and young driver (as stipulated for British Carriagedriving Young Members) who completes 3 National or Regional events in one calendar year (the National Championships may count as one of the events). Multiple prizes will not be awarded.
Stabling:	All entries will be allocated permanent stabling as part of their entry fee. 4-in-hand: 5 Stables, Pairs & Tandems: 3 Stables, Singles: 1 Stable. Only shavings are permitted as bedding and are available on site if required. Horses and Ponies must not be kept in portable stables. Please report to stable manager on arrival, and park as directed. When using our all weather surfaces for training, please ensure you pick up your animals' droppings.
Electric Hook-up:	Electric Hook up for duration of event: £45.
Caravans and additional vehicles	Extra vehicles / caravans incur additional fee (£45) if parked in electric hook up area.
ATVs/Scooters	ATVs and scooters are permitted on the showground but only with written permission from the organiser.
Dogs	Dogs welcomed, but must be kept on leads.

A completed International Team Selection Form must be forwarded to the British Carriagedriving Office prior to the event or, at the very latest, be handed to a British Carriagedriving Council Member prior to you starting at your first selection event, i.e. this must be before you begin your Dressage Test! (Selection Forms can be downloaded from the web site or obtained from your Class Representative).

If the driver is under 18 years of age, the name of a responsible adult (over 18) who will be able to attend in case the driver's horse(s) are selected for drug testing, must be given on the entry form.
