REQUIREMENTS

GENERAL BACKGROUND

- General knowledge of Carriage driving trials.
- Physically fit and mobile enough to carry out duties.

SPECIFIC SKILLS

- Knowledge of the rules and regulations regarding carriage driving.
- Ability to be able to liaise with event organisers, officials and volunteers.
- Ability to fulfil the requirements of a course designer.
- Ability to produce accurate documentation in a timely manner.
- Ability to design and build accurate flowing cones courses.
- Ability to design, layout and measure obstacle routes.
- Willingness to support new trainees.

GENERAL SKILLS

- Ability to remain calm and focused even in tough situations.
- Basic computer skills.
- Good communication skills.
- Positive and Friendly attitude.
- Strongly self-motivated, determined and proactive, result driven.
- Ability to learn and to work under pressure.
- Drive teamwork and collaboration.
- Flexibility and team-working oriented.
- Sense of initiative.
- Availability to travel.
